20. Anticipated Products & Processes of Practical/Technological utility /Socio economic relevance evolved if any.

- A large number of beneficiaries have started Bin composting/Box composting and Vermi-composting of the house hold organic waste to get high quality natural manure for their kitchen garden and thus helping in considerable reduction in disposable waste to be transported for further segregation or to be carried to landfill sites.
- Many beneficiaries, taking a cue from Waste to Wealth techniques taught to them, started making beautiful craft items from discarded household goods reducing the waste for disposal.
- During interaction with the visitors and the GSDP students it transpired that there is a lack of active participation from the household residents in Solid Waste segregation process which is the starting point in SWM process. This needs to be addressed vigorously with legislative support to keep any habitation clean.
- **Mission LiFE** - It has evolved during interactions that greater motivation is required to be cultivated among the younger generation for them to remain associated with Mission LiFE themes for longer periods and to create a large base of Mission LiFE volunteers by appointing them as Honorary Ambassadors of Mission LiFE so that they remain committed to the propagation of its messages in the society at large.
- **World Water Day** - In order to remind the visitors of the grim reality of a Waterless World, an area around a now defunct Hand pump has been turned into a Public Gallery with the theme "Imagine a Day without Water".The shock of not getting any water from the hand pump leaves a lasting impact on the visitors of a water scarce world delivering the intended message.

Making Sulabh-IIHH a Mission-LiFE Centre for dissemination of Mission-LiFE messages to highly impressionable groups of the society like Students of Nursing, Medical College students, the Sanitary Inspector students and college and school children and making them life time members of Mission-LiFE to spread its messages in the society.
