Impact and Legacy

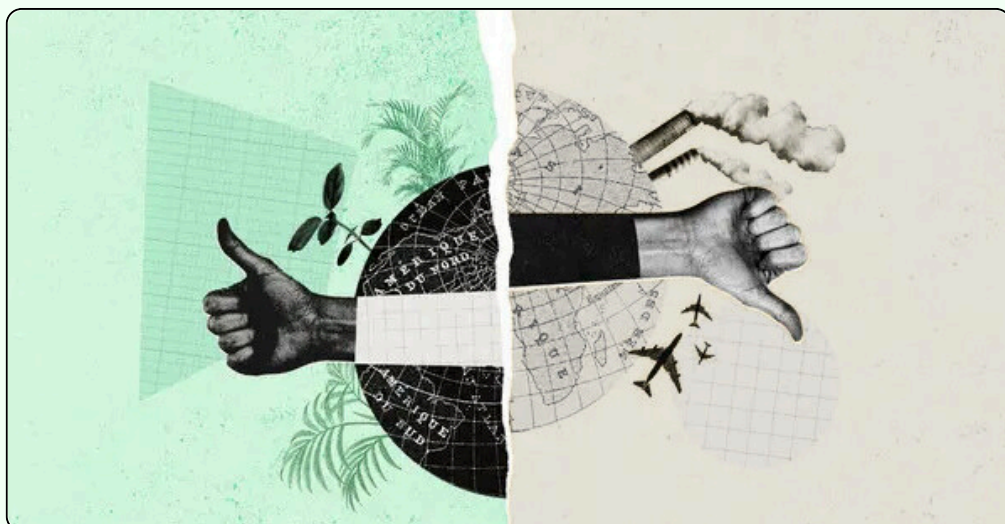

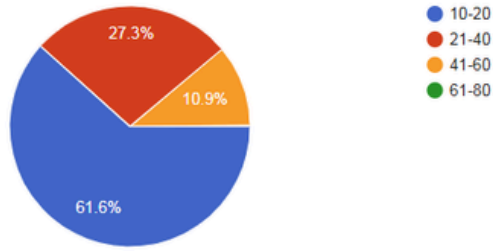

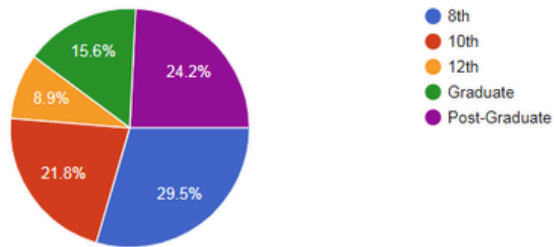

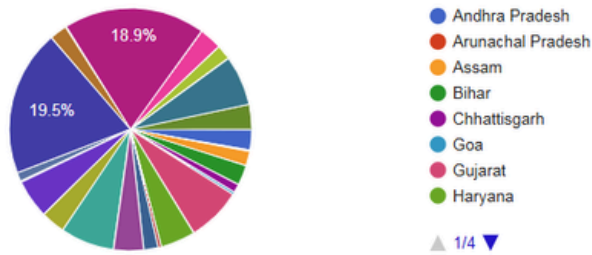

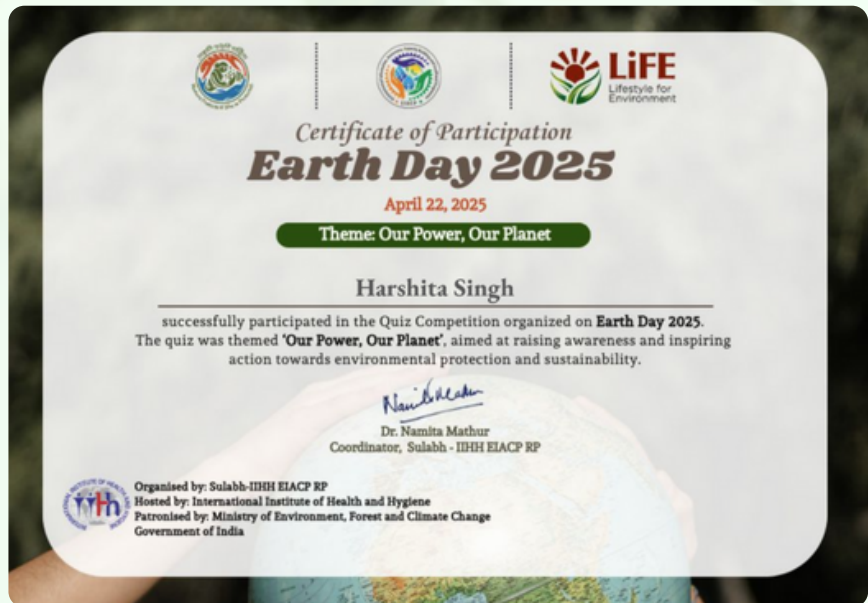


Graph of questions who scored correct responses
