## OVERVIEW

The event aimed to raise awareness among students about sustainable living and the importance of adopting environmentally responsible habits in everyday life.

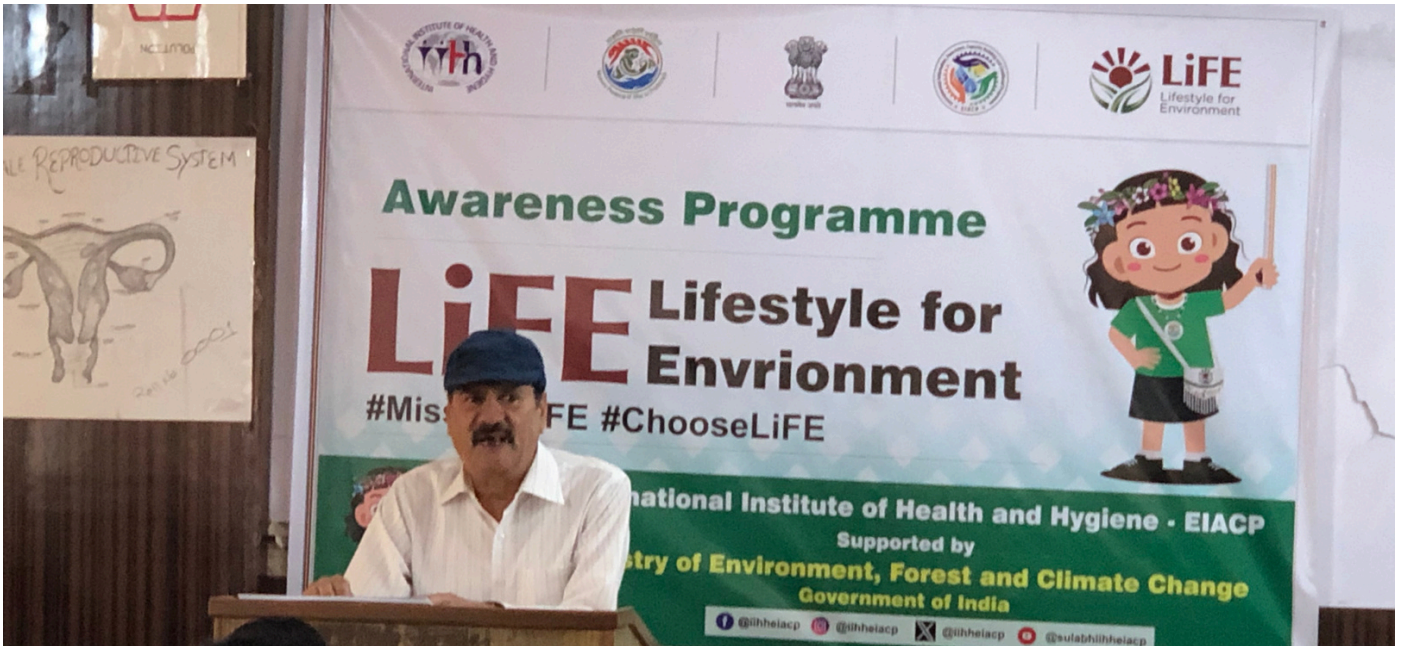
The program commenced with an inspiring address by Shri G. S. Yadav, who introduced the seven core themes of Mission LiFE—namely Save Energy, Save Water, Reduce Waste, Adopt Sustainable Food Systems, Adopt Healthy Lifestyle, Reduce E-Waste, and Promote Sustainable Transport. He emphasized that small, mindful actions, when practiced consistently, have the power to generate significant environmental benefits and lead to long-term positive change.

Around 100 students participated in the session with enthusiasm and actively engaged in discussions on various environmental topics. They shared their own ideas and practices, stressing the importance of switching off unused lights and appliances, conserving water, minimizing single-use plastics, and planting more trees. Their participation reflected a strong sense of responsibility and awareness towards environmental conservation.

As part of the program, Mission-LiFE brochures were distributed to the students to equip them with practical tips and actionable steps to adopt sustainable habits in their daily routines. These brochures served as a ready reference for continuing their environmental efforts beyond the session.

The event concluded with the students taking a collective Mission-LiFE pledge, affirming their commitment to protecting the planet through conscious and responsible actions. The program successfully instilled a sense of environmental stewardship among the participants and encouraged them to become ambassadors of change within their communities.
