## INTRODUCTION

World Ozone Day is observed every year on **16th September** to commemorate the signing of the Montreal Protocol in 1987, a landmark global treaty aimed at phasing out substances responsible for ozone layer depletion. This agreement is considered one of the most successful environmental accords, with universal ratification by all UN member states. Over time, coordinated international action has significantly reduced the emission of ozone-depleting substances and set the ozone layer on the path to recovery.

The 2025 observance, themed “**From Science to Global Action,**” underscores how scientific discoveries about ozone depletion translated into effective global policies and action. It reflects the journey from early research findings to international cooperation, showcasing the power of science in driving environmental protection.

The ozone layer serves as a critical shield that absorbs harmful ultraviolet (UV) radiation from the sun, protecting human health, ecosystems, agriculture, and marine life. Without this protective barrier, the Earth would face severe consequences, including increased skin cancers, eye cataracts, weakened immune systems, reduced crop productivity, and disruption of aquatic food chains.

World Ozone Day emphasizes the importance of continued vigilance and commitment to preserving this life-supporting shield. It highlights the collective achievements of the global community while reminding us that environmental challenges require persistent action, innovation, and international cooperation.

The observance of World Ozone Day 2025 serves not only as a celebration of past successes but also as a call to action for the future. By learning from science, strengthening policies, and fostering sustainable practices, humanity can continue to safeguard the ozone layer and ensure a healthier, safer, and more resilient planet for generations to come.

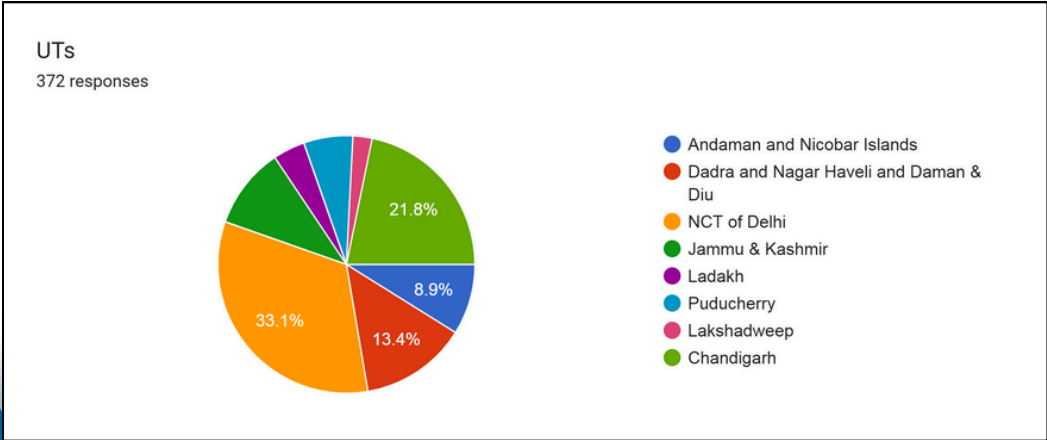

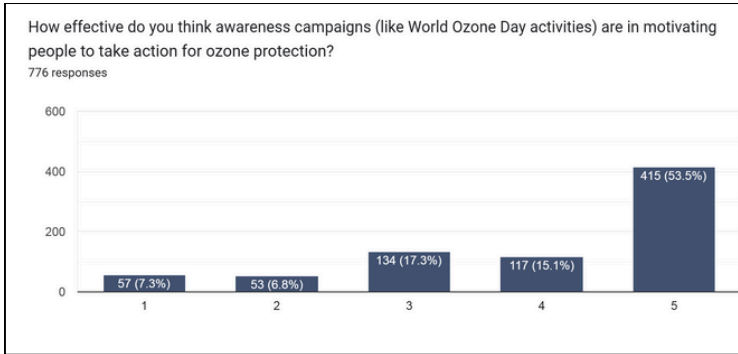
